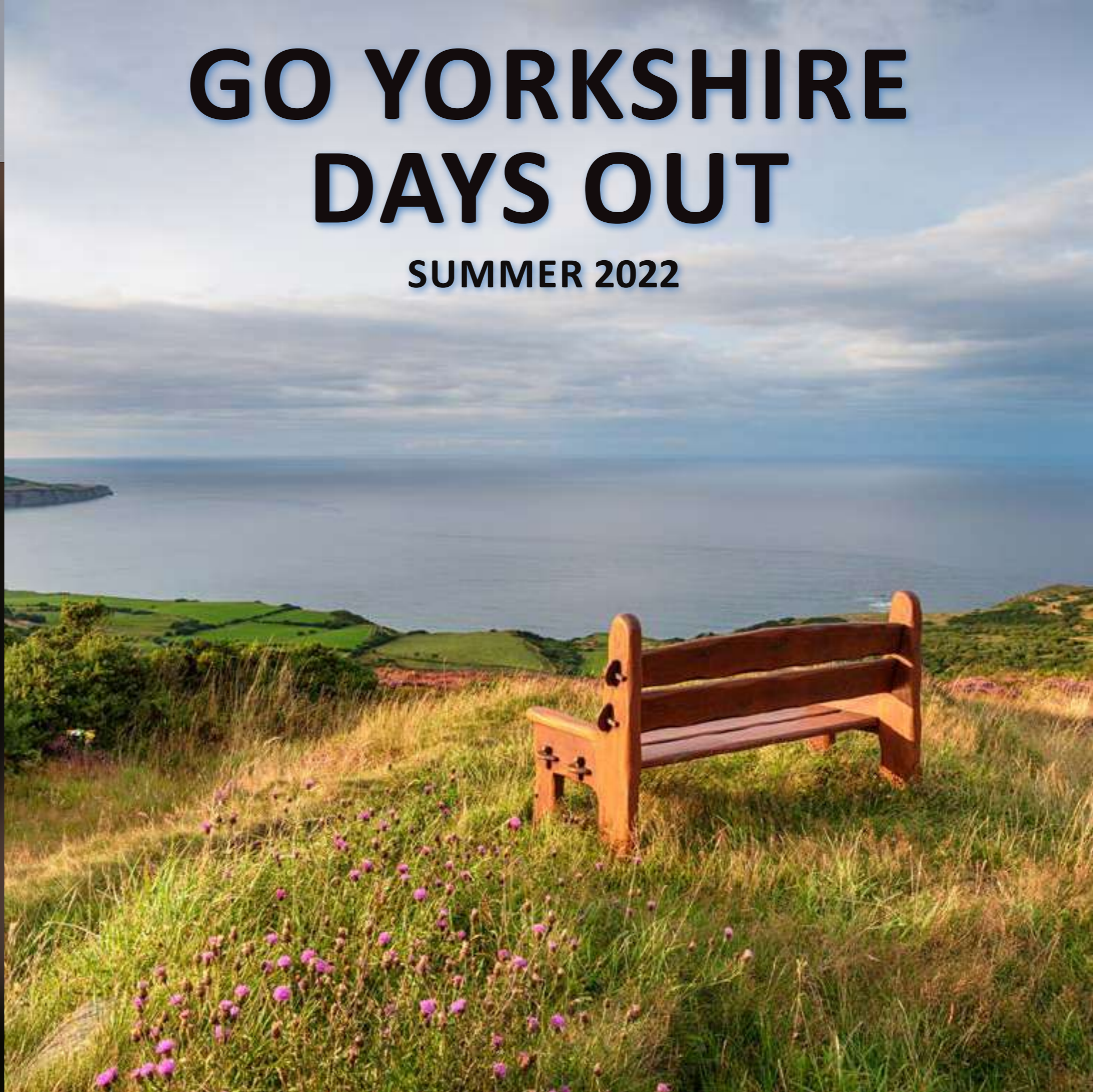

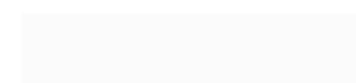
A warm ‘Go Yorkshire’ welcome

The story begins at the handsome 17th century harbourside house now the Captain Cook Memorial Museum. This is where the great explorer, James Cook, came to serve his apprenticeship in Whitby in the year 1746. It belonged to Cook's master, the Quaker ship owner, Captain John Walker. When the young Cook was not at sea, he lodged here in the attic with Walker's 'other family' of apprentices. Cook's voyages were the 18th century equivalent of today's missions to Mars. For ten years Cook and his crews explored the unknown, uncharted waters of the Pacific, the South Atlantic, and the Arctic Oceans. Danger was ever present. The thought-provoking collection of original paintings and drawings, letters in Cook's own hand, ship models, maps and fascinating objects gathered on the voyages illustrate the Cook story. New special exhibition every year. 2022 - 'Sea Peoples – Navigating the Pacific'. Describes the ways Polynesians and Europeans overcame the greatest of the world's oceans

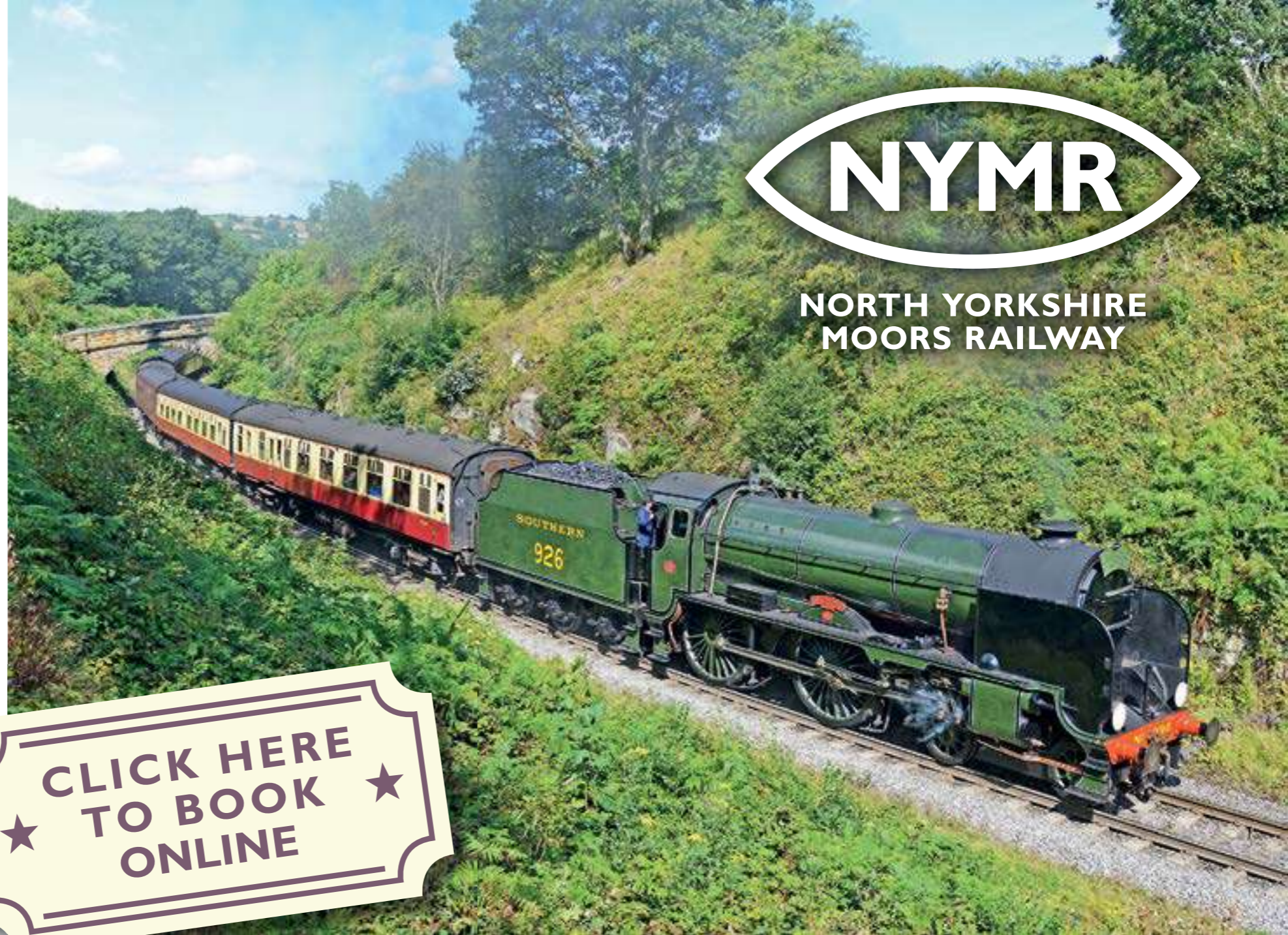

A Summer of fun with The JORVIK Group

Summer fun for all the family is on offer from the JORVIK Group of attractions in York this summer, with Vikings galore, the chance to become an archaeologist, an open stage where you can star in Shakespeare's plays and a unique perspective on one of York's gateways await – and tickets are valid for a full year of repeat visits.

A staple part of every visit to York should be a trip to JORVIK Viking Centre, the only place where you are immersed in the sights, sounds and even smells of 10th century York! Descending from modern street level to the historical level of the Viking city, a Viking guide talks you through what archaeologists found when exploring this very site during the construction of the shopping centre above, with a glass floor revealing what the archaeologists found as they peeled back the layers of mud.

From there, climb aboard a time capsule for a trip around Viking-age York. Painstakingly recreated using over 30 years of research into what was found at the archaeological dig, visitors are 'flown' through the streets and backyards of Coppergate as it would have been in the year 984AD. Each seat in the time capsule has its own screen and a choice of 18 different commentaries – including a children's version and 14 language versions. Whilst on the ride, visitors can't help but notice the sounds and aromas that add a multisensory experience – from the damp forest as you arrive at the outskirts of the Viking-age city, to the smell of burnt wood as you pass a home lost to fire, and even a cesspit where a Viking named Bogar is contributing to the human waste as you fly by!

Disembarking the ride, the artefact gallery displays the remarkable finds made during the Coppergate dig – including the skeleton of the Coppergate woman you saw on the ride, with a fascinating interactive screen so that you can look at her features and ailments more closely. You can see the world's largest Coprolite (fossilised human poo), and an exceedingly rare find, a knitted Viking sock!

Especially for 2022, visitors can see some of the finest silver items unearthed as part of the Silverdale Hoard – on loan from Lancashire County Museum Service – including fine silver bangles, rings, coins and hacksilver, which are small bars of silver with measured marks that could be used for buying goods. The Silverdale Hoard remains at JORVIK until February 2022.

If your appetite for archaeology has been whetted, pop over to DIG: An Archaeological Adventure, the family-friendly attraction that helps create a new generation of archaeologists with training in digging (in mess-free soil!) and understanding what the finds are. The last tour every day at DIG is called DIG Deeper, aimed at an adult audience with more in-depth presentations from our expert team.

At the JORVIK Group's restored medieval townhouse, from 23 July, the literary works of William Shakespeare and their relevance to the people of York will be explored in The Bard at Barley Hall, featuring costumes from popular plays, including Romeo and Juliet and A Midsummer Night's Dream. Visitors can dress up and perform their own scenes on the interactive stage. Finish off a visit with refreshments at the brand new Barley Hall Coffee Shop, also opening in July.

And finally, York's city walls are one of the most popular attractions in the city – but how much do you know about the walls themselves? Find out more at York's newest visitor attraction, City Walls Experience at Micklegate Bar (open April to October), where you can even take an optional tour of the Micklegate Quarter with one of our expert guides.
